EXTRA SPACE EXPANDS MARKET SHARE IN SOUTH KOREA PROMPTED BY INCREASING INTEREST IN VARIOUS LIFESTYLE PURSUITS

SEOUL, 1 OCTOBER 2014 - Extra Space Self Storage, Asia's leading self storage company, will open its second and largest facility in Korea on 1st October 2014. Located in the heart of Bundang in the district of Seongnam, South Korea, the new facility will become the largest self-storage facility in South Korea. It will initially occupy two floors and progressively expand to seven floors by 2017 as demand warrants.

The new facility, serviced by the Bundang-Suseo expressway, is strategically positioned just 10 minutes from Yatap station and 30 minutes from Seoul's affluent commercial centre and the Gangnam district.

Three quarters of current customers in the Extra Space Yangjae facility in Gangnam use Extra Space for personal storage with the balance of the space being used for commercial storage. The company has recently seen an increasing trend towards using such facilities to store recreational and outdoor equipment.

"Residents in South Korea face a dilemma that's common in many of Asia's developed markets - space scarcity. Despite this, South Koreans aren't prepared to compromise in their pursuit of a more active, alfresco lifestyle, which often requires specialist equipment such as camping and golfing gear. We see a significant opportunity for self-storage of these items, which present a challenge for many households, given the limited size of accommodation in South Korea", comments Kenneth Worsdale, Chief Executive Officer of Extra Space Self Storage.



With unit sizes ranging from 16 square feet to spacious walk-in units of 450 square feet, Extra Space provides its customers with scalable solutions to suit their storage need for both leisure and business. Rental periods can be as short as two weeks, or as long as a lifetime. The company also provides 24-hour access seven days a week and highly secure storage units, providing customers with reassurance and flexibility.

Many small companies and start-up CEOs also choose self-storage to support their business needs, as rental costs of commercial space in South Korea is significant for storing files or inventory.

The new Extra Space facility is located at 537-2 Yatap-dong, Bundang-gu, Seongnam-si, Gyeonggi-do province and alongside its first facility, located at Yangjae-dong 216 Seocho-gu province will provide extensive self-storage options in South Korea. Following this latest expansion, Extra Space now manages 21 facilities serving over 8,500 customers across Asia.
